WAM calculations allow for the maturities of certain securities with periodic interest rate resets to be shortened. Generally, for money market funds, WAM can be used primarily as a measure of relative sensitivity to interest rate changes. WAL: A measure of the average final maturity of all of the underlying money market instruments in the fund, weighted to reflect the relative percentage ownership of each instrument. Unlike WAM, WAL calculations do not allow maturities to be shortened for periodic interest rate resets. Accordingly, WAL will generally be higher than WAM.

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
