The Year-to-date amounts on your "ACCOUNT STATEMENT" in the "SUMMARY" section represent the following:

Long Term Capital Gain	This amount represents a long-term capital gain distribution paid by the Fund during 2025 which for tax purposes is treated in the same manner as profits realized on the sale of securities meeting the holding period requirement for long-term treatment.
Taxes Withheld	If applicable, this represents backup withholding required by Federal regulations.

Attention Shareholders Subject to the Federal Alternative Minimum Tax:

The percentage of interest earned by the Fund for the year 2025 from its investment in certain specified private activity bonds which is to be treated as a preference item for purposes of the Federal alternative minimum tax calculation was **19.02%**.
