A portion of your Massachusetts State tax exempt bond Fund's **2023** capital gain distribution is attributable to net gain realized on the sale of certain Massachusetts Municipal Obligations which is **exempt** from Massachusetts personal income tax. To determine the non-exempt portion of your Fund's long-term capital gain distribution to be reported on Massachusetts, Schedule D, use the following instructions:
